RSSN, SHLN, and COVID-19

Our planned RSSN and SHLN educational workshops for the month of March had to be postponed for a future date due to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) outbreak. As our team adapted and heard the concerns of the Resident Service Coordinators and Supportive Housing Operators we decided to team up with the Corporation for Supportive Housing (CSH) and host a COVID-19 response related webinar on March 25th. This webinar was attended by 250 professionals in the affordable and supportive housing sector.

This webinar focused on providing educational information around COVID-19, sharing resources related to food, cleaning, and protective equipment, as well as creative solutions for supporting your tenants and colleagues during these challenging times. NAMI San Diego shared ways to support positive mental health during this time and how to support those with mental illnesses. As a means of learning from one another, there was an opportunity to share best practices and discussions took place on how each property has been adapting to the crisis. While identifying what the unmet needs, we are working together to bring resources where they are most needed and to provide a safe community to interact and socialize with common goals.
