2020 Board Elections

Board Elections for 2020 were held with three Board Members being re-elected to serve second terms: Lori Holt Pfeiler, Habitat for Humanity, Brian Woods, San Ysidro Health, and Nick Hamilton, Red Capital. Two newly appointed Board Members were also elected, Diep Do, California Housing Partnership and Ted Miyahara, San Diego Community Housing Corporation.

Diep Do is the Director-San Diego Region for California Housing Partnership Corporation. She provides financial consulting, technical assistance and training to nonprofit and government clients throughout Southern California. Diep has 20 years of experience in affordable housing finance and development. Diep was previously the Director of Housing Development for Satellite Housing and Tenderloin Neighborhood Development Corporation. At TNDC, Diep oversaw the development of more than 1,600 affordable homes for San Francisco's lowest income residents, totaling more than \$600 million in financing.

Ted Miyahara oversees all operations of San Diego Community Housing Corporation (SDCHC) including housing production, management and organizational activities. San Diego Housing Commission where he oversaw multifamily housing development lending

Prior to joining SDCHC, Ted was Vice President of Multifamily Housing Finance at the San Diego Housing Commission where he oversaw multifamily housing development lending activities, the issuance of multifamily housing revenue bonds, and asset management of the multifamily loan and bond portfolio. Ted also served as a project manager for two nonprofit affordable housing developers in the San Francisco Bay Area and Orange County.
