First Line Cook Training Opportunity

- This 14-week program includes eight weeks of classroom kitchen training delivered by world-class chefs followed by six weeks of on-the-job training in respected New York City restaurants.
- Interested candidates must attend an Info Session (exact schedule coming soon), where they will learn more about the program requirements and complete an online application.
- Based on their application, some candidates will be invited to participate in a Tryout Day and interviews with Employer Partners.
- The goal of First Course NYC is to seamlessly transition participants into full-time line cook work at the conclusion of this program.

Overview:

- The program prepares job seekers to become line cooks through a 14-week apprenticeship consisting of 8 weeks of classroom and 6 weeks of paid, on-the-job training. Apprentices are given metro cards, dinner, and \$125 stipend/week for the 8 weeks of classroom training
