

He Kope Kona: A Celebrated Tradition

Mai kinohi mai i ka makahiki 1970, ua ‘imi ‘o Kona Coffee Cultural Festival e mālama, ho‘omau a e ho‘opaipai aku ai ko Kope Kona mo‘omeheu kūlana kaulana. I kēlā me kēia makahiki i ka mahina o Nowemapa, ‘o ka mo‘olelo o kō Kona Kope e ho‘olaha ana me nā kama‘āina a me nā malihini ‘oiai i he umi lā o ia ho‘olaule‘a.

‘O ke kope ke kahua o kā Kona ho‘okele waiwai kahi o he mau hanauna o nā mahi‘ai e ho‘omau ai ka mo‘olelo me nā ‘ohi pākahi a pau. Aia he mau 650 ā keu mahi ‘ai kope ma ka mokupuni ‘o Hawai‘i. Ulu pono ka lā‘au kope Hawai‘i ma ka lepo Pele waiwai a me ke kūlana aniau hemolele.

‘O nā huaka‘i ka‘apuni mahi‘ai kope, he paikau, he kā Kope Kona heihei malakona hapa, he ho‘okūkū lekapī Kope Kona a pēlā aku nō. ‘O ia kekahi mau hanana o ia ho‘olaule‘a nei.
