

Kahi E Hui Ai Ka Nui 'Ike Manu

Aia ma Hawai'i wale nō he 70 a 'oi lāhui manu i 'ike 'ole 'ia ma kekahi wahi a puni ka honua – 'o nā mea laha i ka lehulehu e like me ka Nēnē, ka 'Io a me ka Pueo, a me nā lāhui laha 'ole pū kekahi.

E komo pū i ka ho'olaule'a no ko Hawai'i mau manu kūikawā a me nā kaiapuni e kāko'o ana iā lākou ma ka Hawai'i Island Festival of Birds, lā 14-17 o Kepakemaka. 'O ka makahiki 'ekolu kēia e mālama 'ia ka hanana e hui ai nā mea na'auao no nā manu, a me nā kānaka aloha manu o nā pae makahiki like 'ole. Ma laila e 'ike 'ia nā ha'i'ōlelo, nā hanana kamali'i, ka pāheona pili i nā manu, nā papa pa'i ki'i a me nā ki'i'oni'oni manu.

E mālama 'ia nā huaka'i kilo manu ma ka 'āina a ma ke kai, a me nā huaka'i ma ke ala Hawai'i Island Coast To Coast Birding Trail – he ala 90 mile mai kahi 'ao'ao o Hawai'i Mokupuni a i kekahi 'ao'ao aku ma ka 'āina malo'o, ka 'āina uluwehi, a me nā 'āina a pau i waena.

He hanana kēia e ho'ona'auao i ke kaiāulu me ka ho'oulu kālā pū no ka Hawai'i Wildlife Center, he hui kia'i a mālama manu ma o ka mālama olakino, noi'i, ho'ona'auao, a mālama papahana.
