



REALTOR® Code of Ethics Training Membership Requirement

What is the Triennial Ethics Requirement

Cycle 8: January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2027

The National Association of REALTORS® requires that all members complete 2.5 hours of ethics training that cover specific topics during each three-year cycle (triennial). The current Cycle 8 ends December 31, 2027. Training is enforced and tracked by the local REALTOR association - Mid Jersey Association of REALTORS.

The REALTOR® Code of Ethics requirements focuses on training members on the REALTOR® Code of Ethics, while the NJ continuing education requirement focuses on general real estate ethics. The REALTOR® Code of Ethics requirement is necessary to renew membership with the Association, while the New Jersey Real Estate Commission continuing education requirement is necessary to renew a real estate license at the end of the licensing term.

What if You Miss the Deadline of December 31, 2027?

- Beginning on January 1, 2028, MJAR will suspend memberships for members who have not completed the NAR Code of Ethics training for Cycle 8.
- Suspended members must still adhere to the Code of Ethics and pay REALTOR® dues to renew membership.
- Access to essential services such as Supra, REALTORS® Property Resource® (RPR), and certain MLSs will be impacted.
- Suspended members have until February 28, 2028, to complete the training to avoid termination of membership.
- On March 1, 2028, any member who has not fulfilled the training requirement will have their membership terminated.
- To reinstate membership, agents must provide proof of completed Code of Ethics training and may be assessed a reinstatement fee.
