BALLOT MEASURES: State, County, Local

RETAIN ALL JUDGES

PVRW utilized the **2026 Judicial Performance Review** to evaluate the judges appearing on the ballot.

We recommend voting YES to retain (rehire) all judges on the ballot.

The best way to make lasting changes to Arizona's judicial appointments is to elect strong conservative leadership. Arizona's governor plays a critical role in shaping the judiciary by appointing judges when vacancies arise, subject to the state's judicial-selection process.

141	YES	FREEDOM TO MOVE: Prohibits the government from ever tracking, taxing, or limiting how many miles you drive. No Government Monitoring!
142	YES	END GOVERNMENT DEI: Closes DEI loophole mandates in hiring throughout state & local government.
144	YES	SECURE ELECTION RESULTS: Citizen only voting; requires government-issued voter ID; bans foreign funding in our elections.
316	YES	CAP GROCERY TAX: Prohibits local government from imposing or increasing a tax on the sale of food items without voter approval; caps tax rate at 2%.
317	YES	DRUG CARTELS: Declares drug cartels to be terrorist organizations.
318	YES	NO BOYS IN GIRLS' SPORTS: Protects girls' sports from biological men participating; includes restrooms, locker rooms and other private spaces.
319	YES	PHOTO RADAR: Prohibits the government from using traffic photo enforcement systems without voter approval; requires voter approval every 10 years.
320	YES	SPEND DOLLARS IN THE CLASSROOM: Requires at least 60% of school funding to go directly into the classroom instead of funding administration.

413	YES	MCC JAILS: Passed by Legislature for renewal at same rate; Public safety keeps jails well-funded.

SUSD	NO	\$375M CAPITAL BOND ISSUE: No Plan resulting in an estimated tax increase of +0.2589. (Est.\$156/year on a \$600K home)
SUSD	YES	SALE OF CLOSED PROPERTIES: Authorize sale of three (3) closed SUSD school properties (Cholla, Apache, Oak).
CCUSD	YES	SALE OF DESERT SUN CAMPUS: Authorize sale of Desert Sun campus (closed).
FHUSD	NO	MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS BUDGET OVERRIDE estimated at +0.1675; renewal.(Est.\$101/year on a \$600K home)
PVUSD	NO	MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS BUDGET OVERRIDE estimated at +0.5827; renewal. (Est.\$350/year on a \$600K home).
PVUSD	NO	DISTRICT ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE OVERRIDE; Education & operating expense + 0.1334. (Est.\$80/year on a \$600K home),
