HB 2009 delivers a long-overdue tax exemption for the brave men and women who deploy to protect your freedoms. At the very least, that's what their service deserves. HB 2376 strengthens election transparency and integrity by leveling the playing field and giving you more information at the ballot box. And HB 2323, a new "Lemon Law" twenty years in the making, finally ensures you receive the same warranty protections on a leased vehicle as you do on a purchased one. Arizona was one of only two states without these protections, and I secured them.

None of this work happens by accident. I grew up watching what makes Arizona special: hard work, neighbors who show up for each other, and a fierce commitment to the freedoms that built the West. Before I ever ran for office, I built a small business in Scottsdale that served NFL athletes and ASU football players at my sports medicine facility and hosted a fitness television program for 18 years. That entrepreneur's mindset of listening carefully, solving real problems, and delivering results is what I carry with me into every committee hearing and every floor vote on your behalf. There is more work ahead, and I'm asking for your support in continuing to deliver for LD4.
