

Epic Order-Specific “Locks”

Lock	Description
Medications & Orders navigator section	<p>Ambulatory users typically place orders during a patient’s visit in the Medications & Orders navigator section. When a user opens the section and adds an order, the section is locked. Typically, there are not multiple users attempting to sign or modify orders simultaneously.</p>
Modifying Orders	<p>Multiple users can place orders for a patient at the same time. Signing orders initiates a lock, so other users can queue up orders but cannot sign them at the same time.
