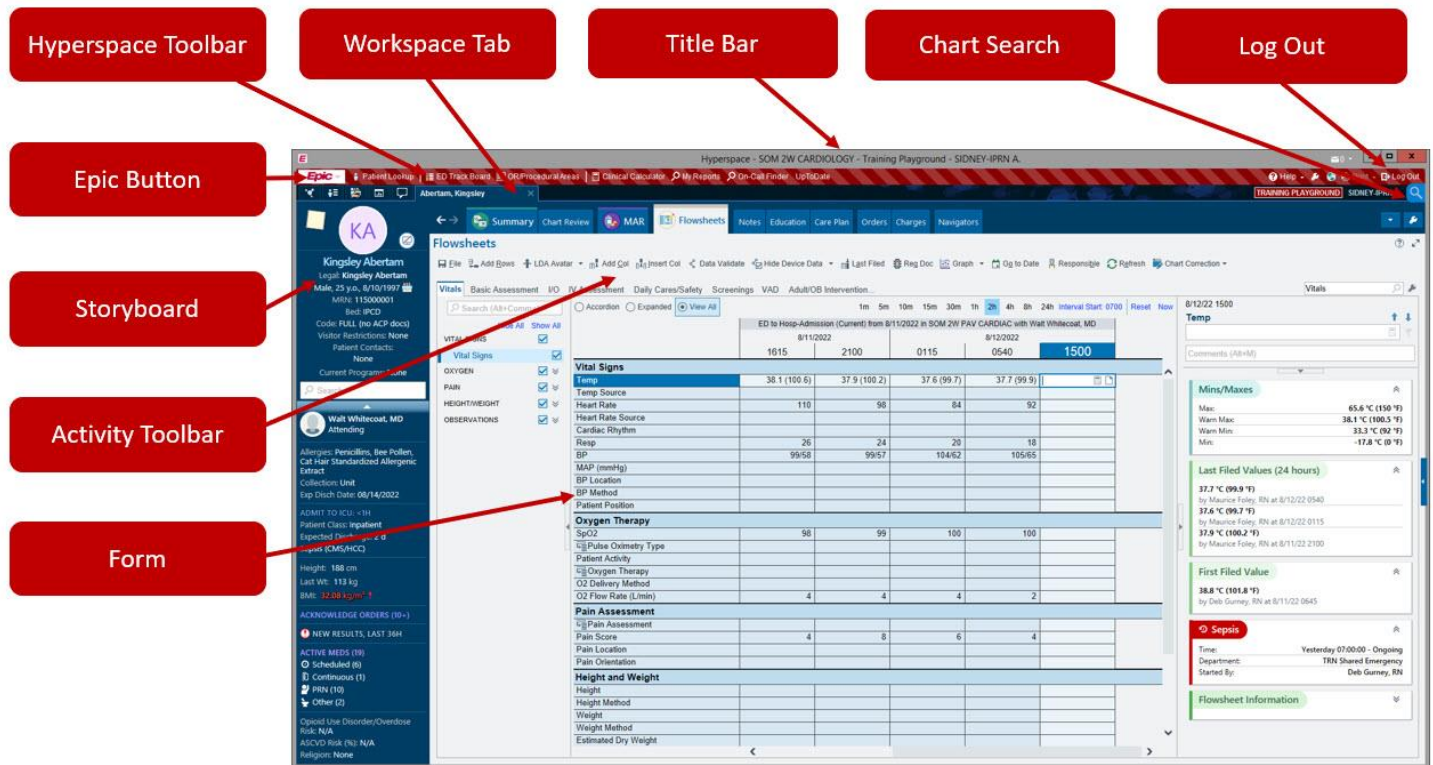


Components of Hyperspace!



Hyperspace is Epic's Graphical User Interface, or GUI. Below, please find definitions to the Components of Hyperspace.

Workspace Tab: Appearing like a file folder tab, the Workspace Tab is the patient's tab you are currently working with; you may have up to four workspace tabs open in Hyperspace. Click the "X" in the upper right-hand corner of the Workspace Tab to close it.

Title Bar: The gray title bar is static and always displays when logged in to Hyperspace. The Title Bar tells you the environment you are accessing, the login department, and the user signed in to Hyperspace.

Chart Search: Type search criteria in the Chart Search field to locate and access any workflow you can perform in Hyperspace.

Log Out: To sign-out of Hyperspace when you go on a break or your shift ends, click the **Log Out** button in the upper, right-hand corner. Shared workspaces may also use "Tap and Go" functionality to quickly sign-out of Hyperspace.

Hyperspace Toolbar: Displays your most common activities or workflows. The Hyperspace Toolbar can be customized by clicking the wrench in the upper right-hand corner.

Epic Button: Lists additional activities or workflows that you have access to based upon your training and security.

Storyboard lists detailed information about the patient you are currently working with, including name, MRN, sex, primary care physician, and many other details about the patient's medical record.

Activity Toolbar: The Activity Toolbar includes activities or workflows you can take on the form you are currently accessing. Depending on the form you are working on, these buttons may change.

Form: The largest portion of the screen, this is where you will update and enter information for your patient, whether scheduling an appointment, documenting in a flowsheet, or reviewing claims for billing.
