

Rhogam Administration and Requirements

The following tip sheet is intended to clarify requirements for Rhogam administration and where to re-print the requisition slip needed to pick up rhogam.

How it Works




1) Consents are no longer needed for the administration of Rhogam.

- Legal, bloodless medicine, and the workgroup decided there isn't a need for consent for RHOGHAM. It falls under a medication, overall consent for treatment.
- Rhogam is not a highrisk medication, and because of that it also does not require a dual sign off.
- ***There is a requisition form that is needed to pick up Rhogam. Below are instructions on how that process works.***


2) When the provider orders a Rhogam injection, signing the order will automatically print the requisition form to the printer linked to the computer that they are using. Often times, the RN will need to reprint this requisition form. This can be done using the BLOOD SLIP link at the top of the ED Narrator.

3) If Rhogam has been ordered for the patient, the BLOOD SLIP report will contain a section Rho(D) Product Orders section, which can be seen in the screenshot below. From this screen, you will click on the highlighted "Reprint" link.



1) Clicking the "Reprint" link will bring up the Print Preview menu. Select "Order Transmittal" and print.
