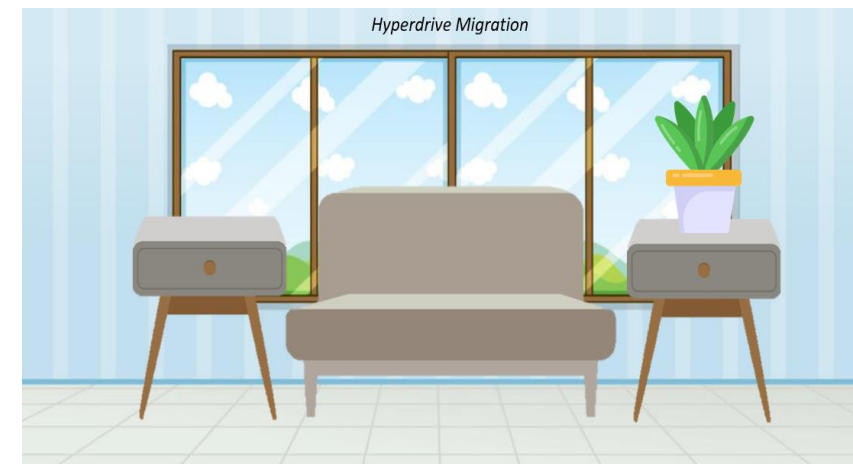
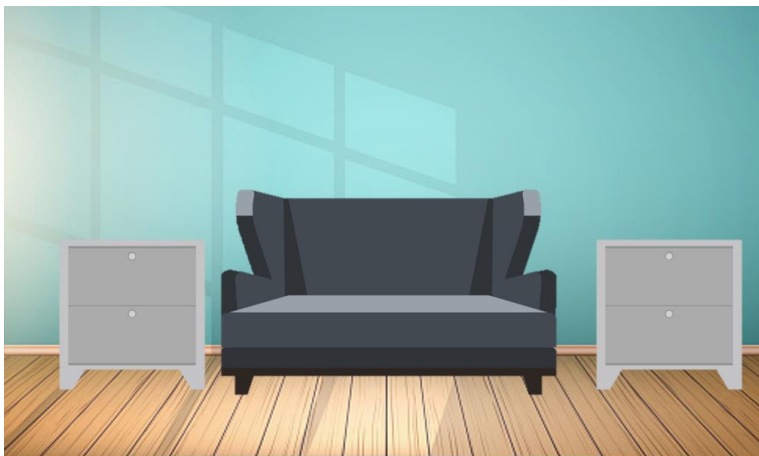


EPIC HYPERDRIVE ROLLOUT

What is Hyperdrive?

- Hyperdrive will update the aesthetics (look) and performance (feel) of your Epic experience via moderately enhanced style and design. In other words, imagine your current living room is the Epic you use today:
 - You may decide to upgrade to a new love seat and end tables (which would be equal the Epic upgrades you have experienced), but now you want to renovate the walls and floor in your living room.
 - These renovations (Hyperdrive) will enhance the look and feel of your living room, but all your furniture will remain the same with some additional décor enhancements.



Hyperdrive & Training

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- No additional in-person or required trainings are needed for the transition to Hyperdrive.
- The Epic Training Team will provide:
 - ▣ Tipsheets published to the Learning Home Dashboards (LHDs)
 - ▣ Your team will also have access to the Hyperdrive Playground environment to review the look and feel ahead of the scheduled rolled

Why Hyperdrive and What Will Be Different?

- Hyperdrive provides increased security, enhanced performance, and more efficiency for future innovation.
- New features:
 - ▣ Workspace personalization - The “You” menu for user settings
 - ▣ Notification hub - review new inbasket messages and chats at a glance and quickly jump to these activities.
 - ▣ The search bar has been relocated to right under the Epic button
 - ▣ Improved patient lookup to now show the search fields and results all on the same screen
 - ▣ Sticky notes now support dot phrases and spell check

When Will We Transition to Hyperdrive?

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- Hyperdrive will be rolled out in 3 phases between 3/10/2024 and 4/27/2024.
