

## Inpatient Nurse: Pyxis Medications

Patient profiles in the Pyxis machines will **ONLY** list the medications that are dispensed via the pyxis machine. The full list of patient medications will need to be viewed in the patient chart.

### How it Works



1. Open Patient chart to the MAR activity
2. Default tab is full list of All medications
  - a. Active medications are listed at the top
  - b. Scroll to view medications that are completed or discontinued separated by the appropriate banner.

3. In the MAR toolbar, Click the **Report** button for a report view of all medications.

**Learn More**

Each medication row will provide information on the dispense location of a particular medication

**Acetaminophen (Tylenol) tablet 650 mg**  
Dose: 650 mg : oral : Every 6 hours PRN : temp > 100.4 F (38 C) :

Admin Instructions:  
\*Fever greater than 100.4 F (38 C)\*  
\*Not to exceed 4 gm/day from all sources\*  
Ordered Admin Dose: 2 tablet (2 x 325 mg tablet)

**lactated Ringer's infusion**  
Dose: 100 mL/hr : 100 mL/hr : intravenous : Continuous

Last Admin: Yesterday 04/23/23 at 2317 (New Bag)

Dispense Location: SMORTHO1 PYXIS

Dispense Location: Floor Stock

**Remember**

With the changeover to Epic, full list of patient medications will NO LONGER be viewable in the Pyxis machine. Only medication orders that will be dispensed by Pyxis will appear in the patients' profile on Pyxis. Full Medication lists for the patient are to be viewed in the electronic medical record.
