- Must be a resident of Wisconsin

Art Contest Rules and Guidelines

- Students are asked to submit a piece of artwork that reflects this year's conference theme.
- Artwork will be judged by the 2020 Executive Planning Committee based on the following criteria:
 - Originality and creativity
 - Relationship of work to the theme: Indigenous STEAM: Science, Technology, Engineering, Art & Math
- The submitted artwork cannot be larger than 11x17". We cannot accept three dimensional pieces.
- Each piece of artwork must be submitted with an official Application and Release form.
- One submission per student
- **The winning selection will receive \$100, runner up receiving \$50**

Contest Deadline

Artwork must be submitted no later than **Friday, February 14, 2020**. Entries that are mailed must be postmarked by that date.
