One member, Deanna Mizell, and her team created a fun competition for the ladies to see how many diapers we could collect at the event and deliver to Daybreak! And the women at Village delivered!! We had 120 women attend our event and they gave generously! We know that it is God that gives all things to us, and that we cannot outgive Him. The women of Village Church know that these gifts will be used to bless many who come through Daybreak’s doors and choose to fight for their child, their family and their legacy.



The Village Church women’s ministry is in its 4th year and meets every Tuesday night from 6:30 to 8 (Sunday mornings at our downtown campus) to study the Bible and encourage one another. As Village continues to outgrow our space with more and more people joining our church and moving into the Northeast/Blythewood area, we are undergoing a capital campaign and expect to have a new building in the next 18-24 months. God has been so faithful! With a new building on Rimer Pond Road we will be able to more than double those we reach in our area and also our gifts to Daybreak. We would love for the Daybreak family to pray for this growth and that we would continue to be obedient to all that God calls our church to do in the days and weeks ahead.
