I came to Daybreak in March of 2025. Since I have been serving, I have been reminded that each client is unique and it's important to let the Lord lead. This is a battle for life and it's impossible without Jesus ministering to the hearts of these moms. We come alongside women who often have little support and have learned reasons not to trust. These moms are learning not just that we care, but that Jesus sees them and He cares.

When a woman walks into Daybreak, she is greeted and connected with a client advocate who listens and engages in conversation to learn what she is going through. While she is waiting for pregnancy confirmation, we get to listen for opportunities to share the Gospel while connecting her with tangible resources. Through Daybreak, she learns she is not alone as we encourage her to make a decision for life. She can get an initial ultrasound by one of our nurses. She can register for the Baby Bucks program to take prenatal/postnatal/motherhood classes and Bible studies through her cell phone which will earn her rewards points – “bucks” – to spend in Taylor’s Boutique. Whenever I get to escort an expectant mom to Taylor’s boutique, she is often surprised by the beauty and abundance of supplies she has access to simply by going through classes which are relevant to her and her child. Each time she interacts with us, we get to build a relationship and spread seeds of the Gospel.



One Mom I was able to meet with had questions about choosing adoption. We talked at length about adoption and the options she has through open and closed adoptions. I was able to put resources into her hands with Christian adoption agencies that she could connect with. She needed a safe place to process her questions and be heard. As I talked with her, I was able to share the Gospel. I explained how we once had a perfect relationship with God in the Garden of Eden and that through Adam and Eve we broke trust with God and our relationship with Him was broken but it didn't end there. While we could do nothing on our own to restore that relationship, God promised Christ would come to save us from our sin. It's because of Christ's perfect life and sacrifice we can have salvation as we trust Him. He is willing and ready to restore our ruptured relationship with God. She listened intently and we continue to have opportunities to engage with her as she engages in the Baby Bucks program. Because of the support and prayers of so many, the hope is she will know, to the depths of her heart, that God sees her, cares for her and her child, and He has a wonderful plan for her and her child. She is not alone and by God's grace she can have eternal life with Him.
