I happened to have a flyer for the next class sitting on the desk and I told her I would text it to her. Hanging up, I was sad for her and her baby.

Two weeks later, I received a text from my client saying she had decided to continue with the pregnancy and wanted to do Baby Bucks. Hallelujah!!! I have continued to check on her and she says she's doing well. What a blessing to see the God of impossibilities move in a young girl's heart~ to change what seems impossible into a hope and a future.
