Project Hope is a primary resource for families needing back to school supplies. Project Hope serves K-12 students in the **Eugene 4J, Bethel, Springfield and Junction City school districts.**

85+ churches, businesses and foundations partner with local school districts to provide supplies to students. Many businesses have partnered with Project Hope in lieu of holding their own back to school events.
