


CATHOLIC CORNER



The Weekend Readings and Thoughts on Christmas – Keeping your Sacramental Life Alive


The second reading this weekend is from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans 26:25-27 where Paul introduces himself to the Christians in Rome and he gives an incomplete synthesis of his theology.

Paul's words remind us to give glory to God this Christmas and always, for the marvelous things he has done for us.

The Gospel is about Mary Saying Yes To God. We can learn from Mary how to pray means to join in her prayer: "Let it be done to me according to your word" (Lk 1:38). Prayer is ultimately self-giving in response to God's love. If we say Yes as Mary did, God has the opportunity to magnify his life in our

life.
