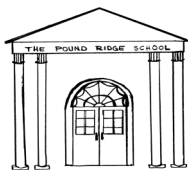

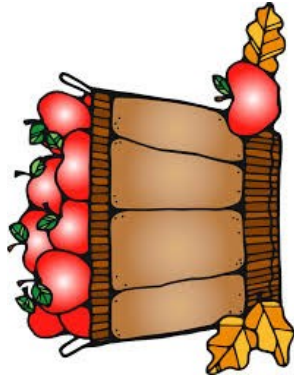

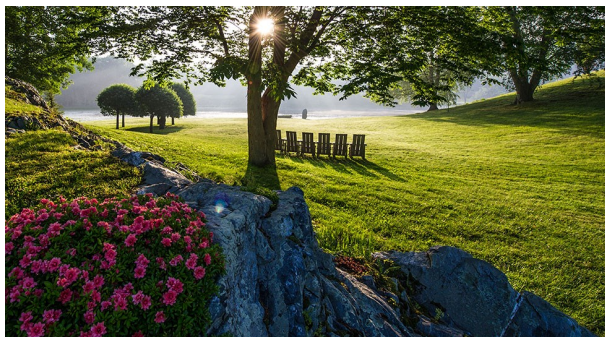

The terrain at Innisfree varies, but is often steep and/or uneven. There are some steps and stairs. There are no paved paths, and walking surfaces include gravel, lawn, pine needles, and packed earth. There are chairs and benches throughout the garden.

THIS TRIP IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR THOSE WITH MOBILITY ISSUES.

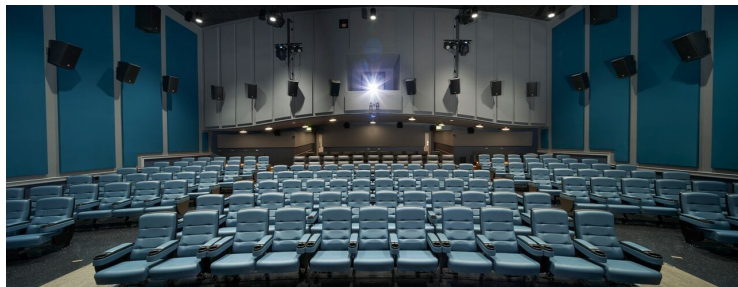
