



Frequently Asked Questions

Who is prom open to?

- Prom is open to Roncalli Juniors and Seniors as well as their dates. Roncalli Juniors and Seniors may bring any Roncalli High School student as their date.

Are non-Roncalli students allowed?

- Roncalli Juniors and Seniors who wish to bring a date that is not a current Roncalli High School Student may bring a guest from another high school. No outside couples will be allowed into our dance via two Roncalli students getting them guest passes.
- All guests will be permitted at discretion of administration. **Any Roncalli Junior or Senior student wishing to bring an outside guest must have a guest pass from Mr. Crissman prior to purchasing their prom tickets.** This guest pass requires a signature of the RHS student's parent/guardian as well as the signature of the Principal or Administrator of the guest's school.
- The minimum age for guests is 14 and the maximum age is 20. All guests must be attending school, actively pursuing their GED, Home Schooling (must provide proof), or have graduated from high school to attend as a guest. Current dropouts or expelled students are not eligible to participate in a RHS function. No middle school students will be permitted to attend this event regardless of age.
- **Guest passes must be completed and returned to the Dean's office no later than March 31, 2025.** NOTE: This is the first day back from spring break, so be proactive!

What time can I arrive?

- Doors Open at 7:30pm
- All students need to arrive by 8:00pm unless you have previous permission to arrive later.
- Students who arrive at 8:00pm will be subject to a substance abuse test per our [Handbook](#).

Where do I park?

- There is free parking available behind The Crane Bay Event Center. The entrance to the parking lot is on the west side of the building, accessed from Merrill Street. Please refer to the last page for a parking diagram!

What do I need to check into Prom?

- All students must show their Student ID - a picture of your ID on your phone will work!
- All guests must have a government or school ID.

What if something happens at the last minute and I cannot attend the prom?

- If there is a sudden change in your plans, please immediately notify Mrs. Moran via email at bmoran@roncalli.org. Any students that have purchased a ticket but do not arrive by 8:00pm will have their parents called to check on status. Tickets are non-refundable.

What is the proper attire?

- Formal attire is required. If your or your guest's attire does not meet the requirements outlined in the handbook and as further required by the Office of Catholic Schools, you will not be permitted to enter the prom. Gentlemen, you must be in suits and your shirts are to remain buttoned and on for the entire event. Ladies, you must be in dresses, skirts, or pant suits that meet the expectations of the handbook.

Is there food available at prom?

- Yes, there is food available at prom. Heavy appetizers and an array of desserts will be offered.

Will there be official photos at prom?

- While professional photos will not be available, we will have a Photo Booth for you to use!

When will I be able to leave?

- The earliest you may leave is 10:30pm. However, we encourage you to fully take in the prom experience up until closing at 11:00pm. Please arrange for any rides to pick you before 11:00pm.
