The 2025 graduation ceremony will be held in Roncalli stadium and no tickets will be required. Seating will be available in the bleachers and in designated areas on the turf.

If severe weather impacts the safety of the ceremony, graduation will be held in the Ascension St. Vincent Gymnasium. If the ceremony is moved indoors, tickets **WILL** be required for all guests. Inclement weather tickets will be distributed on Thursday, May 15, during all lunch periods in the Cafeteria.

Each graduating student will receive 7-tickets. Do not lose these tickets as replacements cannot be provided.




IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Students are not allowed to decorate their graduation cap.
- Diplomas will be distributed in the BC Gym, directly following the conclusion of the graduation ceremony.
- In order to collect a diploma on graduation day:
 - All coursework obligations must be completed and grades received.
 - All obligations to the Dean of Students must be met.
 - All obligations to the Business Office must be met and lunch accounts must be balanced.

Graduation Gown, Caps, and Tassels **MUST** be worn for Senior Mass, Baccalaureate, and Graduation

WHAT TO WEAR UNDER YOUR GRADUATION GOWN:

Students should plan to dress in business-professional wear, under their graduation gown. For men, this consists of a shirt, tie, and dress pants. For women, business-professional means a dress or a top with a skirt or dress pants.

Shoes should look professional, but allow the individual to easily walk up and down stairs and across a turf field. Stiletto-style heels are not appropriate and may get stuck in the turf.

Please dress modestly for potentially warm temperatures.

THINGS TO AVOID:

- Shorts
- Sweatpants
- Denim pants/jeans
- Hats
- Sunglasses
- Tennis shoes/sneakers
- Flip-flops
- Stiletto-style heels with a very thin point
- Spaghetti or thin-style straps
- Off-the shoulder blouses/tops
- Tops that show any cleavage
- Pants that are too tight/short

Only Roncalli-issued cords, medallions, and ribbons will be allowed to be worn on the outside of students' graduation gowns.



Students who choose to disregard dress-code requirements will be asked to change and may not be able to participate in graduation activities.
