THE VICA BOARD OF DIRECTORS HAS TAKEN THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS FOR THE NOVEMBER 5 BALLOT MEASURES

2024 State Measures

Prop 2

Authorizes \$10 billion in state bonds to fund the modernization, construction, and safety enhancements of K-12 schools and community colleges across California.



Support

Prop 4

Authorizes \$10 billion in general obligation bonds to fund projects aimed at improving California's climate resilience, water management, wildfire prevention, land conservation, and renewable energy infrastructure.



Support

Prop 5

Lowers voter threshold for local bonds, increasing bond debt, property taxes, and infrastructure costs, impacting homeowners, renters, and consumers.



Oppose

Prop 32

Constitutes a minimum wage increase to \$18 per hour by 2025, with annual 3.5% or inflation-based hikes, raising business costs and reducing jobs.



Oppose

Prop 33

Repeals parts of the Civil Code to allow local governments full authority to enact or expand rent control on all residential properties, including single-family homes and buildings constructed after 1995.

Prop 34

Mandates that healthcare providers using Medi-Cal Rx program revenue must allocate at least 98% of it to direct patient care, with oversight and penalties for non-compliance to ensure proper use of funds.

2024 State Measures

Prop 35

Makes the Managed Care Organization (MCO) tax permanent to ensure continued funding for Medi-Cal and other health programs, while allowing flexibility in tax rates to maximize federal funding.



Prop 36

Allows felony charges for certain drug possessions and thefts under \$950 if the defendant has two prior related convictions, while also providing diversion programs for first-time offenders and individuals struggling with substance use.



Los Angeles County Measures

Measure A

Imposes a permanent half-cent tax in Los Angeles County, raising costs for businesses and consumers, adding regulatory complexity, and enforcing mandates that will increase expenses and prolong any tangible solutions.



Measure E

Proposes a parcel tax to fund improvements in emergency response, staffing, equipment, and facilities for Los Angeles County's Consolidated Fire Protection District, addressing the growing demand for fire protection and medical services.



Los Angeles City Measures

Measure DD

Establishes an Independent Redistricting Commission to draw Los Angeles City Council district boundaries, ensuring impartiality and public participation in the redistricting process.

Los Angeles City Measures

**Measure
HH**

Mandates financial disclosures for commission appointees, expands auditing and subpoena powers, authorizes temporary manager appointments, and sets a process for evaluating initiative laws.



Support

Los Angeles Unified School District

**Measure
LL**

Establishes an Independent Redistricting Commission to draw Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education district boundaries, ensuring impartiality and community representation in the redistricting process.

**Measure
US**

A \$9 billion bond measure to fund critical renovations, safety upgrades, technology improvements, and sustainability initiatives across Los Angeles Unified School District facilities, ensuring safe and modern learning environments for students.

Burbank Unified School District

**Measure
ABC**

A \$458.2 million bond initiative to fund the modernization and repair of Burbank Unified School District facilities, including upgrades to classrooms, safety systems, and critical infrastructure like HVAC, plumbing, and electrical networks, with strict accountability measures in place.

Glendale Community College District

**Measure
GCC**

A \$600 million bond measure to modernize and repair Glendale Community College facilities, addressing critical infrastructure, safety systems, and upgrading classrooms and labs for career training, with independent oversight and local control of funds.
