## Quarantine Pathway for Covid for St. Philip the Apostle School Students and Staff.

Person has symptoms\*

Person stays home and monitors symptoms May return to school/work with a negative covid PCR test taken in a clinical setting and symptom free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducers.

Person tests positive

Person stays home and monitors symptoms for ten days. May return on Day 11 if symptoms have been gone for 24 hours without the use of a fever reducer.

Person is exposed to covid

If person is asymptomatic, continue to go to school/work, regardless of vaccination status

All must take a PCR test in a clinical setting on days 3, 4, or 5

All must wear a surgical or KN95 mask indoors until Day 10

\*Symptoms include: Fever, Chills, Cough, shortness of breath. difficulty breathing, fatigue, body aches, headache. loss of taste or smell. sore throat. congestion, runny nose, nausea. vomiting, diarrhea

Person who previously had covid is exposed

If person tested positive for covid within the last 90 days and are asymptomatic they are not required to quarantine or test after exposure.
