BAKING HOURS AND CONFETTI EGGS INFORMATION:

BAKING HOURS: Only **2 Festival hours** will be given for Baking. There will be 40 slots available on Sign-up Genius. **Once those slots are filled, there will be 75 slots available for Regular School Hours on a separate Sign-up Genius.** Instructions will be in the September 24, and October 1 Weekly Packet.

BAKING GUIDELINES TO EARN EITHER THE FESTIVAL HOURS OR SCHOOL HOURS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

EACH ITEM WILL COUNT AS 2 SERVICE HOURS:

4 DOZEN COOKIES

4 DOZEN BROWNIES

4 DOZEN CUPCAKES

2 CAKES

2 PIES

4 Quick Bread Loaves (e.g. banana bread, zucchini bread, and etc.)

4 DOZEN RICE KRISPY TREATS

***Sweets Booth Captains will be in touch with all bakers to confirm baked goods.**

2) CONFETTI EGGS: Confetti eggs will only count for **REGULAR** School hours, **not Fall Fest hours**. The Eggs must be turned in between 4 pm and 6 pm to the Novelty Booth on the day of the Festival. ALL eggs need to be FILLED with paper confetti (no Mylar, please). **Unfilled eggs will NOT be accepted.** 3 Dozen Confetti Eggs = 1 Regular Service Hour. No limit to the number of eggs donated, so start saving them now!

Important Information to Know About Fall Fest Service Hours

- Families under tuition plans A & C are required to complete **4 hours per family** at the FALL FEST, or be billed \$400.
- Sign ups will be completed via Sign-Up-Genius. **Sign Up Genius will be available for sign ups on Tuesday, October 2nd at 9:00 PM.** Specific instructions will come out in the Monday school packets prior to October 2nd.
- Most jobs are filled on a *first come, first serve* basis.
- Families are responsible for signing up for the required hours (4), and for working the shifts they signed up for. Families will also submit their Fall Fest hours via SPA's Web site for approval.
- **Families can work more than 4 hours. Hours worked beyond the required 4 will be counted towards Regular School Service Hours.**
- Sign-Up Genius will close Tuesday, October 9th at 5 pm and then your shift is locked in.

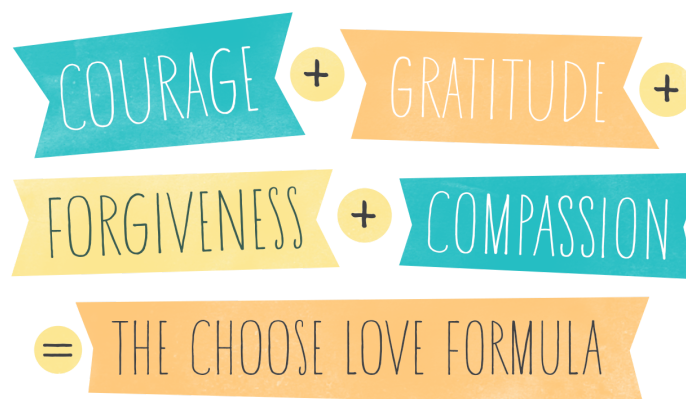
