**Week One - June 19-23**

8:30-10:15

**Incoming Kindergarten Art with Mrs. Slater and Mrs. Renn**

Incoming kindergarteners come and enjoy the fun becoming familiar with your new school, while creating beautiful works of art. Spend a week using different mediums of art. You will create projects that your parents will cherish forever.

**Cooking with Mrs. Gripp grades 1-5**

We are headed to Central and South America! There is so much to explore from the ground to canopy. Your child will discover what exciting animals call the rainforest home. It will be a fun week of arts and crafts, food, and literature.

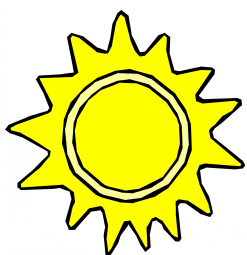
## The Rosary and Our Blessed Mother

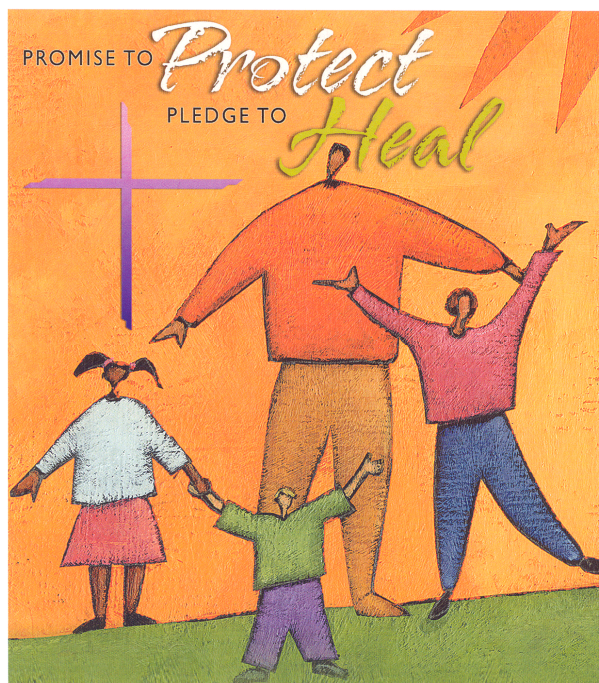
