2019 Preservation Achievement Awards Nominations

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS - 4 p.m. on Friday, January 18, 2019

Preservation Dallas' annual Achievement Awards recognizes outstanding projects involving the preservation, rehabilitation and enhancement of Dallas' historic buildings and neighborhoods. An award ceremony and cocktail reception will be held in May to recognize award winning projects.

AWARD CATEGORIES

- Rehabilitation or Adaptive Use of a residential historic building.
- Rehabilitation or Adaptive Use of a commercial, institutional, or mixed-use building.
- Rehabilitation of a Historic Landscape, Park or other Historic Resource.
- New Construction/Infill in a historic neighborhood. This can include an addition directly attached to a building, or an entirely new building (infill) which enhances the historic nature of the original building or streetscape or urban environment.

APPLICABLE PROJECTS

The 2019 Preservation Achievement Awards will be considered for projects completed after January, 2013, and located within the City of Dallas or its immediate vicinity. A project may be nominated by the property owner or by another individual or group, such as a neighborhood organization, building contractor or architect.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Nominations must be submitted using the nomination form provided on the following page. The form should include a project summary and photographs. If you are nominating more than one project, please submit each entry separately.

Please ensure that the following is included in your submission:

- Project nomination fee due upon submission. \$50 for residential projects and \$100 for non-residential. Please make check payable to Preservation Dallas or call 214-821-3290 to pay by credit card.
- All materials must be clearly identified with the name/address of the nominated project.
- Appropriate credit must be given to project participants (owner, architect, contractor, craftsmen, etc.).
- Photographs - Submit ten to no more than fifteen photos of the property. High resolution (minimum of 400 dpi), quality digital photos (jpeg format) will be accepted. Please include exterior and interior shots focusing on the historic character of the property. All images should be labeled (i.e., front entry, east side of building, main stairwell, etc) and include a credit line for publication. Before and after views of the project are strongly encouraged. All images should be in focus with proper exposure.
- All nomination packets must be submitted with hard copies and a CD or thumb drive with Windows compatible electronic copies of the materials. The nomination form can be filled out electronically and saved as a PDF. Materials that were not created electronically should be scanned and copied onto the storage device.

SUBMISSION

Please submit materials to Donovan Westover at Preservation Dallas, 2922 Swiss Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75204. All submissions must arrive by Friday, January 18, at 4 p.m. All submissions become the property of Preservation Dallas and will not be returned. The nominator grants permission for materials to be used by Preservation Dallas for presentation and publicity purposes. For questions regarding a nomination please call 214-821-3290.

All entries will be judged by a jury of independent preservation and design professionals. Nominations will be evaluated using the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties. Please visit <http://www.nps.gov/history/standards.htm> for details. Criteria include but are not limited to: Sensitivity to the historic integrity of the property and its historical features, craftsmanship, and impact of the project on the preservation of Dallas' historic fabric (downtown or neighborhood). The jury may request to visit nominated properties prior to making an award. Award nominees and winners will be notified prior to the public announcement of the awards.
