WOLVES WIN!!

The Wolves came out firing on the defensive end and in transition as they took an early first quarter lead 10-6. Eastlake would continue their aggressive play in the second quarter forcing the Kangs into many tough contested shots. The Wolves would head into the halftime break with 15-10 lead. LW would out score Eastlake 7-3 in the third quarter to close the gap to 18-17. After a fiery speech from Coach “Pops” Jones, the Wolves locked in and put on a defensive clinic to start the fourth quarter. Girls' Basketball

JV:

The girls' JV basketball suffered its first defeat of the season at Lake Washington on Friday, April 23rd. The Wolves lead except for the final two minutes as the Kangs came storming back. **Ashlea Slocum** had 9 points and was dominant of the boards. **Jordan Humphrey** contributed 8 points and rebounds and **Darcy McCoy** had 7 points. The Wolves' efforts fell short 39=36. The Wolves got back on their winning ways against Juanita with a dominating win. **Darcy McCoy** pumped in 11 points and **Ashlea Slocum** a double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds. **Allie Hunthausen** was a strong contributor with 8 points and strong post play.

Varsity:

On Friday 4/23 the Lady Wolves traveled to Kirkland to take on the Lady Kangs in the 2nd of three meetups for the season. The Wolves had a slow start in the first half and dug themselves an early hole as they entered halftime down 15-25. Eastlake came out in the second half energized, and with key defensive stops and some sharp shooting by Ava Schmidt closed the gap to 7 at the end of the 3rd. The Wolves outscored the Kangs in the 4th quarter which brought them within 2, and with 5 seconds left forced a jump ball that went in favor of the wolves. Despite getting a last second shot off the Lady Wolves fell to the Kangs 47-49. Schmidt led all scorers with 16 points shooting 50% from the field and grabbed 12 boards marking her first double-double of the season. Senior Kaitlyn O'Brien added 9 points and 9 rebounds, shooting a critical 5-6 from the free throw line. Fellow Senior Emily Holsan added 8 points and also ripped down 9 rebounds.

Wednesday 4/27 the Wolves made the trek back to Kirkland, but a little farther north to take on the Juanita Ravens. The Wolves came out fast looking to run and cause chaos in the backcourt, which led to a 26-7 first quarter score. The contest resulted in a 64-13 win for Eastlake and was a true team victory, finding contributions from everyone, on both sides of the ball. Sophomore Ava Schmidt for the second game in a row led all scorers with 20 points, 6 rebounds and 2 steals. Senior, Emily Holsan seemed to be unable to miss as her 17 points and 3-6 shooting beyond the arc would attest. She also had 7 rebounds and 3 assists on the night. Junior Hallie Sehlin was a beast on the boards with 10 and contributed 6 points. Freshman Genevieve "GG" Hastings capped off the defensive effort by taking the first charge of the season for the Lady Wolves. Next up – The mustangs return back to Eastlake on Senior Night for the Wolves.

EHS Wrestling hosted a double duel against Juanita HS and Redmond HS on Wednesday the 28th.

Against Juanita, our four seniors all picked up big wins. Ethan Henderson (145), Isaac Morse (170), David Darroch (182) all won handily by pin. Isaiah Collins (113) received a win by forfeit. Junior Evann Tauscher also picked up a 50 second pin for the team. Despite some good wrestling, Juanita came out on top with a final team score of 30-46.

Against Redmond, our four seniors again dominated the mat. Ethan Henderson (145) pins his opponent in 48 seconds, Isaac Morse (170) defeats his opponent late in the second round, David Darroch (182) pins in 43 seconds, and Isaiah Collins (113) locks in his pin early in the second round.
