## **Fastpitch**

### **Varsity**

## **Track & Field**

### **HOM AND WOLF WINNERS AT SHORELINE INVITATIONAL**

Several members of the Eastlake track team had the opportunity to compete in the Shoreline Invitational on Saturday April 30<sup>th</sup>. Vying against athletes from over 60 teams, Connor Hom and Fiona Wolf took top honors for the Wolves in the meet.

Running in his specialty the 800m, Hom won the event handily while leading from start to finish with a time of 1:57. He has positioned himself well for the championship season that starts next week with a 3<sup>rd</sup> place position in King Co and 8<sup>th</sup> in the State 4A rankings.

Wolf, who set the school record in the 2000 m steeplechase a few weeks ago, had another exceptional race winning the Freshmen 1600m in a personal best time of 5:18.4. She is now 4<sup>th</sup> on the all-time Freshmen list for Eastlake.

Addy Keller who just set a personal record of 10-09 in the pole vault in the meet against Skyline last week recorded another personal best vault of 11-00, giving her a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish. The number three all-time vaulter at EHS and PLU recruit is ranked 6<sup>th</sup> in 4A.

Other notable performances of the day included:

\*Jane Roos placed third in the 3200m running a personal record of 10:55. She has moved to 4<sup>th</sup> all time for Eastlake, passing Chelsea Orr who was an All-American runner at the University of Washington.

\*Ethan Pedersen set a 10 second PR in the 1600m, running a 4:19.8 and placing 8<sup>th</sup>. He has moved to the number five position on Eastlake's all-time list and is right behind Adamson Bryant who competed for Duke. He is currently ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in 4A in the event.

\*Emily Van Valkenburg also set a personal record by 10 seconds running a 5:07 in the 1600m and placed 6<sup>th</sup>. The Oregon State recruit has moved to the 7<sup>th</sup> spot on the all-time list and is ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in the 4A standings.

\*Eli Yoon placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the Freshmen 1600m in a personal best time of 4:50.3. He is now ranked 8<sup>th</sup> on the all-time freshman list.

\*Justin Hom placed 7<sup>th</sup> in the 400m in a personal best time of 52.49. He did this after running the final leg of the distance medley relay that placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. Joining him on the distance medley squad that ran a time of 11:12 were Daniel Montano, Quinn Hulet and Yoon. His 400m time gives him a 9<sup>th</sup> place ranking in King Co.

\*The girls distance medley relay that consisted of Ariya Mathrawala, Claire Wilson, Claudia Wolf, and Peyton Quinto placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the meet running a time of 13:30. They are now the 4<sup>th</sup> ranked team all time for Eastlake.

Next Up: A group of wolves will head to Lake Washington High School on Friday May 6<sup>th</sup> to better their marks in hopes of qualifying for the KingCo Meet in the Last Chance Qualifier. The distance squad will run at Liberty High School on the 6<sup>th</sup> in a distance carnival.
