



Restaurant Revitalization Fund NOW OPEN

The Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) began accepting applications via the application portal on Monday, May 3. The application portal will remain open to any eligible establishment until all funds are exhausted.

For the first 21 days that the RRF program is open, the SBA will prioritize funding applications from businesses owned and controlled by women, veterans, and socially and economically disadvantaged individuals including Hispanic, Black, Native American, and Asian American and Pacific Islander-owned businesses.

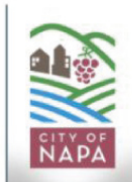
