Wednesday, April 28th at 9:00 AM through Tuesday, May 4th at 5:00 PM Notifications will begin Friday, May 7th Eligible applicants: current waitlisted small businesses and/or nonprofits not selected in Rounds 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 and new applicants that meet eligibility criteria.

Details: Applicants not selected to receive a grant in Rounds 1, 2, 3 & 5 do not need to re-apply and will be automatically moved into Round 6. New applicants will need to apply on the website: California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program (careliefgrant.com)

Restaurant Revitalization Fund Applications start Monday, May 3rd

The Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) will begin accepting applications via the application portal on Monday, May 3. The application portal will remain open to any eligible establishment until all funds are exhausted.

For the first 21 days that the RRF program is open, the SBA will prioritize funding applications from businesses owned and controlled by women, veterans, and socially and economically disadvantaged individuals including Hispanic, Black, Native American, and Asian American and Pacific Islander -owned business.
