Joseph Stringer writes and speaks on Christian issues in the current culture. His prayer is that all who read his works might see through them to the One who has chosen us for life. His latest book, *Alien Nation: Why We Can't Talk; How We Heal*, addresses our divisions in America today. What drives the alienation which plagues us? Stringer outlines four crucial steps which can help us to reconcile with one another.

Stringer's previous works include two novels, an illustrated children's book, music, and poetry. His book *The Ten Commandments for Business* witnesses how we are to apply the Ten Commandments in our business lives to transform our companies from "bottom line profit" to "top down mission." His novels are set in America in the near future, and he is not sure if these books, first envisioned in the 1980s, are fantasy or prophesy. In *The Gem Testament*, Christians have been pushed out of any public setting—something that is coming true today. *The Chosen* finds them hunted throughout America. Stringer's works have been printed in various publications in the Charleston, SC, area and are available on Amazon.

Stringer works as a certified risk manager and certified insurance counselor with Anderson Insurance Associates of Charleston, and he partners with the Coastal Financial Planning Group on risk-planning for business executives. He is the Charleston director for the South Carolina Christian Chamber of Commerce.
