



## Grants for US VOSH chapters to support clinics for US local vulnerable groups

We have funding for 6 USA VOSH chapters to organise humanitarian clinics especially targeting vulnerable communities in the USA. These communities include but are not limited to homeless people, migrants, schools in low income areas, LGBTQ people, victims of natural disasters or elderly people in need.

Each successful VOSH chapter will receive \$1,500 to implement this work.

Interested USA VOSH chapters need to fulfil the following criteria:

- Be a chapter in good standing (2020 membership dues paid)
- The proposed clinic is designed to reach a vulnerable group as mentioned above.
- Commitment to gather data according to the form developed by VOSH/International and submit the data after the clinic
- Commitment to provide high quality pictures and feedback on the initiative for promotional and reporting purposes.
- The clinic should take place in 2020.
