While we have no classes on **Monday, January 16** we will offer the opportunity for our students and families to gather together for service projects from 10am-12pm on campus. In addition, we will be hosting collection drives to benefit local organizations.

Collection Drive Details

- [Purchase items](#) for **Food for Others Power Pack Program** (P3) which sends weekend backpack meals home with students who do not get enough food without their school-provided meals. **Drop off at WWS no later than 10am on Monday 1/16** so that they can be assembled that morning.
- **Food Drive** in partnership with Holy Comforter - Saint Cyprian Roman Catholic Church (Stacey Kornegay's church) to stock their local food pantry helping DC neighbors in need. **Drop off Jan 16 - Jan 20.**
 - canned tuna/salmon/chicken
 - pancake mix & syrup
 - canned vegetables
 - potatoes & fruit
 - peanut butter & jelly (plastic only, no glass)
 - sardines
 - vienna sausage & potted meat
 - cereal

- WWS has long supported the **Samaritan Ministry of Greater Washington**. They welcome donations of \$25 grocery gift cards to Giant, Safeway, Walmart or Target. **Drop off Jan 16 - Jan 20.**
- Assist refugee families by donating to the [Migrant Solidarity Network](#) which is a collection of 20 local non-profits that have organized under a single umbrella to assist refugees arriving at Union Station. **Drop off Jan 16 - Jan 20.**
 - Gently Used Infant and Children's Clothing: **Warm clothing for children ages 6-18 years is the greatest need.**
 - Winter Gear like Gloves, Hats, Scarves, and Jackets for all ages and genders. **Gloves and jackets are needed most.**
 - Feminine Products: These are always in great need. (Pads or liners only.)
 - Unopened Bags of New Underwear: all genders, ages, and sizes.

- Gently Used Men's and Women's Clothing: Sizes XS, S, M. **Pants are needed most for all genders.**
- Gently Used Sensible Shoes (Ex. no high heels or flip flops): all sizes and genders.
- Gently Used Backpacks, Large Tote Bags, and Small Suitcases (so they don't have to carry their items in trash bags).
