RE: 2022 Canvass of Voters

To: All Registered Kent Voters

The Registrar's of Voters are currently compiling lists of voters to be included in our yearly canvass. The Canvass is conducted to determine if a voter still lives at the address they have on their registration card. Voters to be canvassed are those for whom we have information that indicates they may have added a PO Box number or other mailing address but still live at their residence; have moved from one location in town to another; have moved to another town in Connecticut or have moved out of state.

Beginning Mid-February and ending May 31<sup>st</sup>, Voters for whom we have a phone number will receive a canvass phone call from the Registrars or the Deputy Registrars, others will receive a letter. You have 30 days from the date of the phone call or letter to respond. Failure to respond will result in your name being placed on the In-active Voter List. (To be restored to the Active List you have to fill out a new registration card before you can vote.)

Also, if you have not voted in an election since 2018 your name may be removed from the voter rolls. If you wish to remain a registered voter please contact the Registrars office.
