The Club serves a hot and hearty breakfast every Sunday morning. The greatest population served is the homeless. Six meals were served on the first day. As word has spread, some Sundays have seen upwards of 160 visitors!

The Breakfast Club serves a dual purpose. In addition to providing a much-needed meal, it's an opportunity to reach a greater number of people with the gospel. Every club meeting includes a devotional along with an invitation to join the worship service. While the church service is optional, Major Wes says the message of God's life-changing love and power is still being shared.

The community enthusiastically supports the program. Volunteers are plentiful as members of other churches, the advisory board, United Way, and the corps give their time to make sure breakfast is served and the message of Jesus is heard.
