Below is the latest from Massachusetts (March 26, 2020) with regards to real estate services during the Governor's Declaration.

What real estate brokerage services are considered essential? SEE SPECIFICS BELOW

Open houses: While open houses are not prohibited, they are subject to the Governor's order about limiting gatherings to ten people and the DPH advisory to stay home. If an open house is held, the number of people in the home should be limited to 10 at a time and social distancing should be enforced.


Real estate closings: Can continue, with social distancing for any inperson transactions

Realtor meetings with clients: Cannot take place at the realtor's bricksand-mortar place of business, but could take place remotely with social distancing, or by phone or video
