

MTA INFORMATION

- The cost of riding the bus is \$1.40. MTA prefers bus tickets as a means of payment for the coming school year. If a student forgot her bus ticket, we will lend her one. We will contact you if your child has an outstanding balance for borrowed tickets.
- To purchase MTA tickets in bulk, please contact one of the parent sale volunteers listed below. This system will enable families to place orders of desired quantities in advance, and offer pick-up from the parent volunteers. In addition, we will offer sale of tickets at Bais Yaakov at the front desk.
- The MTA parent liaison is Mrs. Fayge Hackerman. She can be reached at 410-299-5981 or at fhackerman@gmail.com to purchase tickets or to volunteer as a seller. Our parent ticket sale volunteers are Mrs. Atara Berman (347-642-2245) and Mrs. Sara Feigenbaum (410-585-4115).
- The school does not guarantee a monitor for the MTA bus. While we are looking to find one, parents should know in advance that MTA is not under Bais Yaakov auspices.
- If there is a bus monitor, the one-way cost will be a minimum of \$100 per student or a maximum of \$120 per family. This fee is required at the beginning of the year. Without payment of this fee, students may not ride the bus.
- If students ride only a limited number of days in the week, the fee will be prorated.
