GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS BRINGING CARS TO SCHOOL

Driving a car creates opportunities—and responsibilities. In order to assure the safety of the students attending Bais Yaakov and to provide for greater academic integrity, we have established the following guidelines and regulations for students driving to and from school:

1. Only twelfth graders may bring cars to school on school days.
2. Cars must be parked only in the parking lots and areas that are designated for students. There are no exceptions.
3. Students may not leave the school premises during any part of the school day without express permission from a member of the administration.
4. Any student who leaves school grounds in her car during the school day without permission will be subject to immediate suspension. She will forfeit her right to bring the car to school in the future.
5. Students spending time in their cars on the parking lot during the school day will likewise forfeit the right to bring their cars to school.
6. No unlicensed driver may drive a car on the school premises.
7. Students must drive slowly and carefully on the school premises at all times. Those who fail to drive carefully will be asked not to drive to school.
