\* *My Name Is Barbra* is Streisand's long-awaited and hotly anticipated memoir, in which the living legend finally tells her own story of a groundbreaking life achieving excellence in every area of entertainment. Frank, funny, opinionated, and charming. \$45  
\* The season is absolutely packed with other celebrity bios and memoirs, too: *Madonna: A Rebel Life* by Mary Gabriel; *Being Henry* by Henry Winkler; *My Effin' Life* by Geddy Lee; Jada Pinkett Smith's *Worthy; Energy Follows Thought* by Willie Nelson; *George Harrison, the Reluctant Beatle* by Philip Norman; Patrick Stewart's *Making It So; The Woman in Me* by Britney Spears; *Behind the Seams: My Life in Rhinestones* by Dolly Parton, and *Tupac Shakur: The Authorized Biography* by Staci Robinson. Whew! (Varying prices)

\* A wildly entertaining new history of the Eternal City, *A Rome of One's Own* by acclaimed historian Emma Southon, uses the lives of 21 extraordinary women to upend our understanding of the ancient world. \$27

\* Peter Wohlleben, author of the best-selling *The Hidden Life of Trees*, and his wife, Miriam Wohlleben, deliver an inspired, practical memoir of creating a sustainable home-stead among the trees in *Our Little Farm*. \$24.95

\* *The Goodbye Cat* by Hiro Arikawa follows up her bestselling *The Travelling Cat Chronicles*. Seven cats weave their way through their owners' lives, climbing, comforting, nestling, and sometimes just tripping everyone up in this uplifting collection of tales. \$24

\* The companion volume to director Ken Burns's PBS film, *Blood Memory* is the epic story of the buffalo

in America, from prehistoric times to today—a remarkably moving and beautifully illustrated work of natural history. \$40

\* *The Dictionary People* by Sarah Ogilvie celebrates the unsung heroes who created the Oxford English Dictionary, unravelling for the first time the mystery of the fascinating contributors around the world who, for more than 70 years, helped codify the way we read, write, and speak. \$30

\* *The Frozen River* by Ariel Lawhon is a gripping historical mystery inspired by the life and diary of Martha Ballard, a renowned 18-century midwife who investigates a shocking murder that unhinges her small community. \$28

\* *Alfie and Me* is ecologist Alfie Safina's moving account of raising, then freeing, an orphaned baby screech owl, whose lasting friendship with the author illuminates humanity's relationship with nature, across cultures, and throughout history. (Bonus: adorable photos!) \$32.50

\* From bestselling author Katherine Howe comes a captivating new novel, *A True Account: Hannah Masury's Sojourn Amongst the Pyrates, Written by Herself*. This marvel of historical fiction combines a fast-paced 18th-century story about a female pirate with a 20th-century mystery set in academia, in a page-turner that's exhilarating, dazzling, and gorgeously written. \$28.99

\* Roxanne Gay's *Opinions* is a collection of her best nonfiction pieces from the past ten years, covering politics, feminism, the culture wars, civil rights, and much more, including an introduction in which she reflects on the past decade in America. This sharp, thought-provoking anthology will delight Gay's followers as well as draw in new readers. \$30
