- Aug. 26♦ Last day to amend Political Reform Act bills, Stem Cell Research and Cures Act bills, and bills amending Section 6 of Prop 39 (2000).
- Aug. 27 Last day for fiscal committees to meet and report bills to the Floor of either House [JR 61(a)(12)].
- Aug. 30-Sept. 10 **FLOOR SESSION ONLY:** No committee may meet for any purpose [JR 61(a)(13)] other than: 1) a conference committee [JR 30], 2) to hear bills re-referred to committee pursuant to JR 26.5 or AR 77.2, and 3) Rules Committee meetings of each House [JR 61(f)].
- Sept. 1 Last day to notice intent to remove a bill from the Inactive File *for the purpose of amending the bill by the September 3 amendment deadline.*
- Sept. 2 Last day in the Assembly to submit amendments to the Desk (by 5 p.m. or upon adjournment, whichever is later) if an author wishes to amend by Friday, September 3 [AR 69(b)(1)].
- Sept. 3 Last day to amend bills on the Assembly Floor [JR 61(a)(14), AR 69(e)]. Last day to adopt resolutions on the Third Reading File [AR 74(d)].
- Sept. 3♦ Last day to submit the one-day File notice across the Desk for a conference committee meeting to be held on Tuesday, September 7 [JR 29.5(a)].
- Sept. 7♦ Last day to *receive* a conference report at the Senate or Assembly Desk [JR 30].
- Sept. 8 Last day to notice intent to remove a bill from Inactive File *to be returned to the Third Reading File on September 10* [AR 78].
- Sept. 9-10 Concurrence bills may be taken up without the one-day waiting period [AR 77(a)].
- Sept. 9-10 No reconsideration on bills that pass is in order on the last two legislative days preceding the Interim Recess [AR 100(b)(1)].
- Sept. 10 Last day for any bill to be passed in 2021 [JR 61(a)(15)]. Interim Recess begins upon adjournment [JR 51(a)(4)].
- Oct. 10♦ Last day for the Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature on or before September 10, and in the Governor's possession after September 10 [Art. IV, Sec. 10(b)(1)].

* Absent a suspension of the Rules.

♦ Assumes recess upon adjournment on September 10.
