Testing Schedule

10/28/2020 - Math

11/4/2020 - ELA

11/11/2020 - Language Usage

All 9th and 10th graders will take the math, ELA and language usage MAP assessments over the next 3 Wednesdays. Students will test virtually using the Teams meeting platform and the MAP assessment platform. Your child will receive email invites to 3 Teams meetings - 1 for each Wednesday. Students need to check their school email for these invites.

Students will login to the teams meeting on Wednesdays at the assigned meeting time. Teachers / proctors will meet the students in the Teams meeting and provide instructions and administer the tests. Students will be required to have their cameras on during the testing period so teachers may observe and supervise virtually.

The purpose of the MAP assessment is to measure and monitor students' academic progress. The data gathered will help inform teachers on gaps in student learning and help teachers to plan lessons and remediation to assist with student learning. Please discuss with your child the importance of taking their time and doing their best on these MAP assessments.
