

RGCSL Open House Art Show May 2026

Thank you for participating in our first art show! RGCSL is a vibrant community of creative souls; let's shine that light! Your work will help to beautify our sanctuary for our Open House event on May 2, as well as Reverend Gil's ordination celebration the following weekend. Plans are to keep the art up for the month of May.

There are just a few guidelines you need to keep in mind if you want to participate.

This show is open to members of the RGCSL congregation only. We have plans for future art shows that will be open to the community at large. Our inaugural exhibit is a special showcase just for our home-grown artists at RGCSL.

There is a limit of 3 pieces per artist. All media and themes are welcome.

Pictures must be framed and wired. Sawtooth hangers are not secure and will not be accepted. If you need help wiring your work, Sue Klump will be available on drop-off days with supplies and assistance to get your pieces securely wired. Gallery-wrapped canvases with finished edges need not be framed, but they must be wired for hanging.

You may sell your work. This is optional; you may designate your work NFS ("not for sale") on the registration paperwork if you wish. If you choose to sell the work, RGCSL will collect contact information of interested buyers so that you may make arrangements directly with them. You are responsible for contacting the buyer and for arranging payment and delivery. Please request that buyers agree to allow your work to remain on display for the duration of the show.

We ask that you consider donating a portion of sales back to the Center. This is, of course, optional, but we hope you'll consider supporting the Center and our ability to host future shows with a donation. A tithe of 20% is recommended.

You must submit registration paperwork by April 12. If you are interested in participating, please return the completed registration form to Karen Ford or Sue Klump by April 12th. (Contact info on the form.)

Art delivery dates are Sunday, April 19 and Sunday, April 25, after services. If you can't deliver your work at those times, we may not be able to accommodate your piece(s). *Please contact Sue or Karen if you have any issues with delivery!*

Your pieces must be labeled when you drop them off. Please use the attached form for labeling the physical pieces you deliver for the show. These labels are only for identification purposes – we will be producing professional-looking signage with your name, the name of the work, price, etc. for display in the gallery. We need your completed labels so we can match up the works with the proper signs.

Artists exhibit at their own risk. We will take every precaution against damage and handle your artwork with loving care!
