

STARS (Early Childhood) Survey results

2018

We were thrilled with the response rate and responses from our families. We received feedback from 49% (or 21 families) of Toddler and Children's House families. Many families shared their appreciation for what Hilltop offers, and some had useful suggestions for how we could improve. Below is a summary of the responses along with additional information to share.

1. Rank the following modes of communication used by Hilltop Montessori School.

1 = lowest / 5 = highest

Newsletter: 5.0

Emails (from teachers & class representatives) 4.3

Email blasts: 4.1

2. Hilltop Montessori School offers ample outdoor time and space to meet my child's needs.

Overall score: 3.7

"Age-appropriate outdoor play space exists for the toddlers, Children's House, Elementary, and Middle School student communities. My child enjoys having outside play time, year round, three times a day, while also having time for walks and outdoor activities during PE. My child especially loves having access to the nearby woods for imaginative play with friends, and the sledding hill during after care in the winter."

3. Do you feel that our Toddler / Children's House curriculum meets your child's learning needs?

1 = Strongly Disagree , 2 = Disagree , 3 = Agree , 4 = Strongly Agree

With an overall score of 3.9, the responding parents feel the curriculum meets the needs of the child are being met. Many families report their children are thriving and demonstrating continual growth. Opportunities to offer more complex works in a timely manner for growth was suggested.

"Our children have gone through language explosions after being at Hilltop - just one example of how they've benefitted."

4. Are you satisfied with the snacks and meals offered to your child during the day?

With an overall score of 3.6, responding parents offer suggestions of more variety, with an increased focus on adding organic food, protein and other fats into the daily snack mix as part of a healthy diet. All natural soaps, sanitizers and cleaning products were also suggested as an alternative to the chemicals in conventional brands of cleaners.

We appreciate the attention to the important details of keeping our students healthy and we have already taken strides to make improvements in these areas. We balance considerations of what most children will choose to eat, what we want to present to entice a wider selection of choices, cost, and practicality. When our gardens are bursting with cherry tomatoes we are in good shape! We always welcome donations of organic food options and greatly appreciate the regular donations of organic yogurt from Green Mountain Creamery via the Humfeldts! AND, we do have a community organic garden of sorts springing up.

With care and consideration for the health of the students and staff, we use an environmentally conscious line of cleaning products, Enviro-Solutions. The primary solution used is Hydrogen Peroxide based; we also use a disinfectant solution as is required by the DCF Childcare Licensing Regulations. We have reached out to our distributor to see if there are any new products available since we last reviewed their options. Thank you for your feedback and the prompting to ensure we are using the safest options that meet our intersecting needs of sanitation, environmental impact and fragrance sensitivities. 5. The children play outdoors everyday except for bad weather days.

Overall score: 3.9

6. The program has a predictable routine and is organized.

Overall score: 95.2%

Overall score: 95.2% of respondents agree

8. I trust that my child will be well cared for in every way.

9. Is there anything else you'd like to comment on?

Overwhelmingly, responding parents appreciate the experience their children are receiving from the dedicated and talented staff. Some respondents offer concern for shy or quiet children, noting at times they are not heard or slow to respond, but with patience their response is worth the wait.
