We actually had people leave the conference when they heard that the exchange companies were going to be there because we were all doing these exchanges "behind the back" of our exchange companies and some developers were afraid that if caught doing this horrible thing the exchange company might pull their affiliation.

I was C.A.R.E.'s first President serving from 1985 until 1990. Nancy Meyer of Vacation Brokers served as our next President and this is when we decided to join ARDA and have a booth at their conventions. We snowballed Michelle Huber from American Resorts into making the directory we all enjoy. Nancy was followed as President by Dave Stoenner of Trading Places. Dave was followed by Terry Wilson of Donita's Vacations Unlimited. We then elected Melanie Gring for two terms as President.
