1. Sponsorship Package

About Glenora Community League

For decades, the Glenora Community League has been at the heart of our neighborhood — a place where families, seniors, and neighbors come together to connect, celebrate, and thrive. From recreation and youth programming to cultural events and community gatherings, the League building is a vital hub.

The Glenora Community League building is now over 50 years old and requires extensive repairs. The Redevelopment Committee has created a 5 phase plan to repair the entire building.

To continue serving our community for generations to come, the Glenora Community League is undertaking a **\$3.6 million redevelopment**. We invite community members, local businesses, and supporters to invest in this once-in-a-lifetime project and help us build the future of Glenora.

Redevelopment Plan

- **Phase 1a:** Flat roof replacement
- **Phase 1b:** Gym HVAC replacement
- **Phase 2:** New exterior cladding and gym renovation
- **Phase 3:** Interior renovation of washrooms, preschool, rink shack and the addition of a new community lounge.
- **Phase 4:** Main entrance relocated to south side with canopy, landscaping, and walkways
- **Phase 5:** Kitchen upgrade

Total Cost: \$3.6M

Source of funds

Community League Savings: \$0.25M

Grants to date: \$0.25M

Estimated future grants: \$1.5M

Community fundraising: \$1.6 M

Grants are available in varying amounts and with different timelines from municipal, provincial and federal levels of government. To qualify for these grants an amount equivalent to the grant must be matched by the community. These matching funds can be in the form of money in the bank or pledges from donors. For the period of December 2025 to May 2026 we are going to focus on gathering pledges from the community.

Pledges must be in the form of a clear written letter that indicates the donor's commitment to contribute a specific amount toward the renovation of the Glenora Community League building redevelopment project. It should include a payment schedule and any conditions of the pledge. The donor's pledge needs to be verifiable by the granting agency. We have attached a template for creating this pledge letter.

We need to have pledges on hand for the spring 2026 grant application schedule with the hope of receiving grant funds in the fall of 2026. Donors would then need to disburse their pledged amounts prior to a spring 2027 construction cycle.

These donations will be eligible to receive a charitable donation receipt from the Glenora Community Building Society. The Building Society was set up in 2022 for the sole purpose of redeveloping the Glenora Community Building.

 - **Friend of Glenora – Under \$1,000**
 - Collective recognition on community donor plaque
