VOICES OF CHILD HEALTH IN CHICAGO REPORT

Child Health Status in Chicago

In this [Voices of Child Health in Chicago](#) report, they explore child health and how it is associated with factors at the family level such as parent health, household income, and race and ethnicity, and with factors at the neighborhood level such as local park use and perceptions of neighborhood safety. Some of the highlights include the following: nineteen percent of Chicago parents reported having at least one child in worse health; children who had a parent who currently smoked cigarettes were nearly twice as likely to be in worse health than children whose parents never smoked; there were health disparities for children based on income, race and ethnicity, and neighborhood factors.
