

Fighting the Fraud: Tips for Medicare Security

- 1 Never share your Medicare number with anyone over the phone unless you are sure it's your medical provider.
- 2 Medicare provides the COVID-19 vaccine at no cost to you. If anyone asks for money to get you a shot, it is a scam.
- 3 Medicare will never contact you for your Medicare Number or other personal information unless you've given them permission in advance.
- 4 Medicare will never call you to sell you anything.
- 5 You may get calls from people promising you things if you give them a Medicare Number. Don't do it.
- 6 Medicare will never visit you at your home.
- 7 Medicare can't enroll you over the phone unless you called first.
- 8 Protect your Medicare Number and your Social Security Number.
- **9** Use a calendar to record all your doctor's appointments and any tests you get.
- 10 Know what a Medicare plan representative can and can't do before you join.
- 11 Do not allow anyone except your doctor or other Medicare providers to review your medical records or recommend services.
- 12 Never allow someone else to contact your doctor to request a service that you don't need.
