



2024 SUMMER ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

1. ____ The cost of the summer program is \$300/week for Priority Registration, and \$335/week for General Registration. All weeks for which your child is signed up to attend must be paid in full based on your designated payment schedule (i.e., monthly, bi-monthly or weekly). This tuition is non-transferable and non-refundable. A non-refundable supply fee of \$175 will be collected upon registration.
2. ____ Tuition is due monthly, depending on the tuition schedule you have on file with the front office. You may pay monthly on the 1st of the month using personal check or automated ACH. Or you may pay bi-monthly on the 5th and 20th of the month using automated ACH, or weekly every Friday using automated ACH.
3. ____ Monthly tuition fees are non-refundable regardless of holidays, illness, vacation, inclement weather days or “Acts of God.” Upon enrollment in The School, you are reserving a place in our program, regardless of whether you use all the days designated for that space. The School will make reasonable efforts to open in inclement weather. The School’s ability to open during inclement weather is dependent upon the number of teachers able to safely make their way to the School on such days.
4. ____ The School is closed on Monday, May 27th in observance of Memorial Day and on Thursday, July 4th in observance of Independence Day.
5. ____ The summer camp program is from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. A fee will be charged for any child not picked up by 6:00 pm. This charge shall be \$15 per child for the first 15 minutes and an additional \$5 per child per 5 minute period thereafter. Fees for late pick-up are payable immediately; if not paid, the child will not be readmitted to the program.
6. ____ The School reserves the right to deny, cancel, sever or suspend a child’s enrollment at any time if the School, in its sole discretion, deems such action to be in the best interest of the child or the School. In such event, any unused tuition will be refunded.
7. ____ Children may not attend the School while ill. Children who become ill at school must be picked up immediately - please refer to the School’s health policy.
8. ____ The School will provide a nutritious, well-balanced lunch through a catering company of its choice for every day except Field Trip days. Parents will pack a lunch from home for the child to use on designated Field Trip days. Your child’s summer camp teacher will communicate which days will require a lunch packed from home.
9. ____ The School’s employees are its most important assets. Parents are prohibited from engaging School employees for outside childcare services while the employee is employed by the School. If Parents hire an employee of the School or a former employee (within 6 months of their employment at the School), Parents agree to pay the School a placement fee of \$2,500, payable upon hiring.

The undersigned Parents have received an executed copy of this Agreement and a copy of the Parent Handbook, which includes the health policy referenced in paragraph 7. Parents acknowledge that this Agreement is by and between Parents and Bonhard Ventures, Inc. d/b/a The Goddard School; GSI is not a party to this Agreement. The undersigned Parents understand the terms of this Agreement and agree to be bound by them.
