It is located on the waterfront with a nice dock and boat ramp, beach, sand volleyball court and plenty of room to run and play. It also has a big covered shelter with 10 picnic tables, bathrooms and showers, ice machine, large grill and group campfire ring. It has 20 campsites, each with picnic table, fire ring, water and power. There will be plenty of time to enjoy our time together on the waterfront, a big dinner together on Saturday night followed by a campfire with skits and songs, and members of Sunday Union have offered to play during our worship service on Sunday morning.

This has been a great way for adults and children to build and strengthen friendships within our DCPC family. There are lots of ways to participate! You can come for the day on Saturday, you can come for dinner and the campfire on Sat night, you can come for our Sunday morning worship service, or you can do it all and camp one or both nights!!
